

PRINCIPLES OF THE JUST WAR THEORY

1. Just Cause
 - " Self-defense
 - " Defense of innocence
 - " Violation of recognized boundary

2. Just Intent
 - " The aim is peace

3. Announcement of Intention (issue warning)

4. All means of reconciliation exhausted
 - " Talk it out
 - " Try other means of resolution

5. Appeal to the Highest Lawful Authority

6. Reasonable Hope for Victory

7. Due Proportion
 - " How much force is needed to get the job done?
 - " *Jus in bello*" Just Means"
 - both qualitative and quantitative proportion
 - " Control of collateral damage
