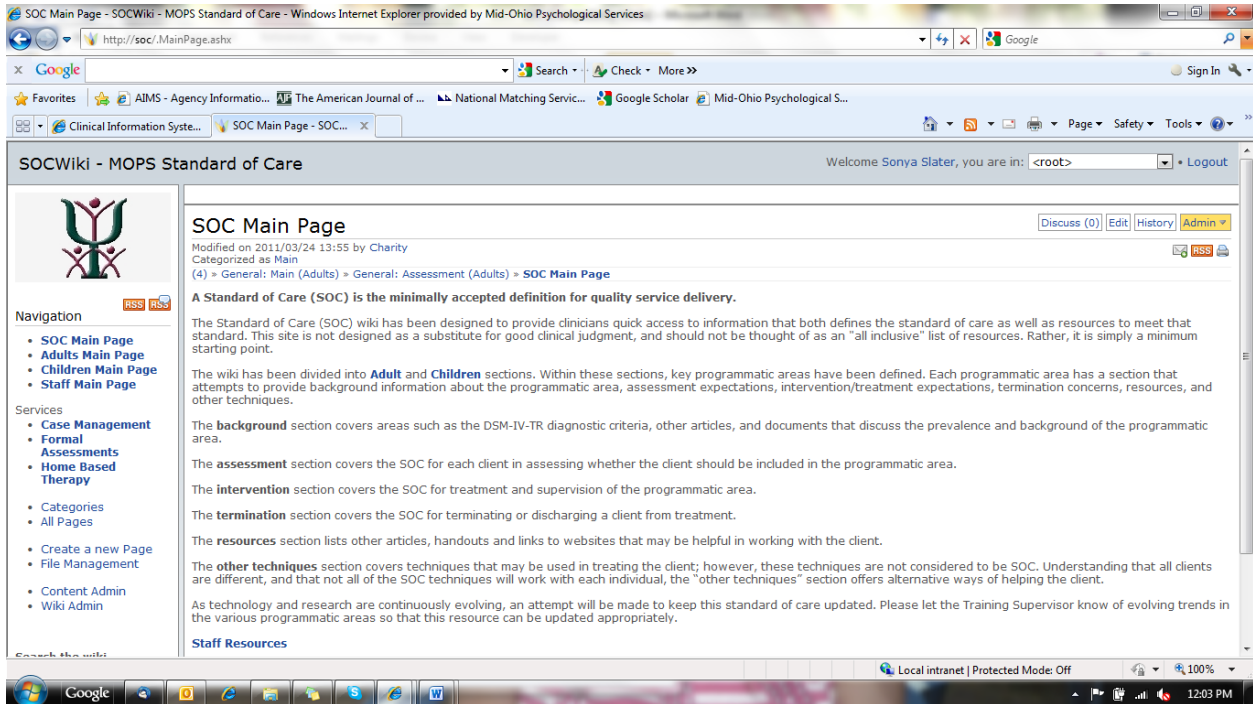


MOPS Standard of Care Website

This is accessed by typing in SOC in the web browser box on any computer connected to the MOPS network.



The Standard of Care (SOC) wiki has been designed to provide clinicians quick access to information that both defines the standard of care as well as resources to meet that standard. This site is not designed as a substitute for good clinical judgment, and should not be thought of as an "all inclusive" list of resources. Rather, it is simply a minimum starting point.

The wiki has been divided into Adult and Children sections. Within these sections, key problem areas have been defined. Each problem area has a section that attempts to provide background information about the programmatic area, assessment expectations, intervention/treatment expectations, termination concerns, resources, and other techniques.

You will be required to select a standard of care for each of your clients and when the QA committee reviews that client chart, it must match the "critical standards" set forth in that SOC. Not all areas have identified "critical standards" and the SOC website continues to be a work in progress.
