

Supervisory Agreement

The supervisory process shall serve to support and encourage further education, professional development and increased knowledge in the areas of psychological assessment and testing, treatment planning, therapeutic interventions, and differential diagnoses.

Goals of Supervision include:

1. To provide diagnostic and case review in order to develop skills related to differential diagnosis, assessment and appropriate treatment interventions.
2. To build appropriate clinical documentation as evidenced through records review and Quality Assurance, according to the Policy and Procedure Manual.
3. To build clinical skills related to conducting diagnostic assessments, therapy session, and case management services.
4. To become more familiar with interpretation and scoring systems of a variety of psychological instruments.
5. To provide resources and information for the development of new skills and competencies.

All client Individual Service Plans will be developed with supervision. All case notes, treatment summaries, and records will be reviewed. The supervision is limited to the clinical work that is conducted by the supervisee through Mid-Ohio Psychological Services, Inc.

One hour of individual face-to-face supervision shall occur for every 20 hours of supervisee work time. The supervisor will not receive payment from the supervisee for supervision time.
